## President's Perspective

*You say you want to show goats??* It's that very important time of year for those of us that are Boer breeders; the show season.

Shows are important to educate the folks looking to get into the business, and also seasoned breeders find out how their breeding program is shaping up to the rest of the industry.

There are so many variables to overcome to get to the top of the class, let alone just getting to the showing.

A month before the show go through a checklist: 1) are your animals structurally correct, 2) are they putting on the proper amount of condition, 3) are they getting pigment under their tails, 4) are their teeth lining up with the pad, 5) is the hair coat smooth and shiny, and 6) are they free of contagious diseases.

The next step is to enter your animals in the show. This is a time consuming operation, but if done properly it will make you check in at the show much smoother. An added benefit is that it will keep the show secretary from putting a curse on your family for generations to come! This is how I make entries...so it must be right. I get a calendar and the show rules. Then make chart of the dates and numbers of each class.

Example: June Jam, June 19, 2004

Class #1 0-3 months March 20, 2004-June 19, 2004

Class #2 3-6 months Dec. 20, 2003-March 19, 2004

Then I pull the registration papers of the ones to show and put them in order, youngest to oldest, in each classification; i.e. Percentage does, Fullblood does, Bucks. Then I fill out the provided show form completely (putting the entries in order by class number), write my check, and send it in long before the deadline.

The last couple of weeks before the show you need to find time to wash and groom your goats, and again go through the checklist. The day before the show as you are loading, again do the checklist, especially #6, and head out. When you get to the show locate the people in charge to find out if there is a penning assignment and where to check in your papers. If there are no penning assignments be considerate of others and don't leave an empty pen between you and the next exhibitor. Keep your feed back so no one else's animals can reach it. Don't pen strange bucks beside each other.

Check in the night before the show when possible. Again sort papers by classification, and in order of youngest to oldest. Substitutions are accepted at check in.

I always need to remember, no matter how many problems I have had getting to the show, to suck it up and get over it. The people running the show are not getting paid and they have been busting their backs to put the show together so we can just unload our families and animals. It probably won't kill any one of us to be courteous and appreciative of the show committee.

Well I better quit stalling and go get something done. If my ranting's can help just one person, my life has meaning.

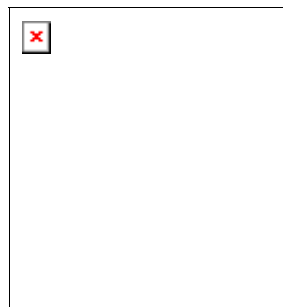

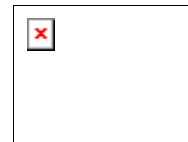
